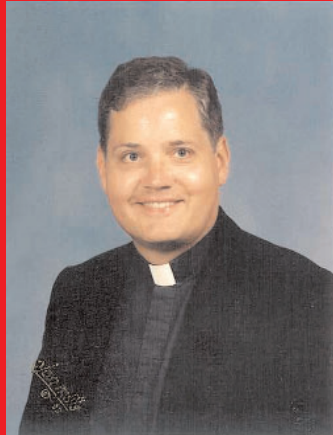

Father Stan Klores

Father Stan Klores was born in Evanston, Illinois, and as a young man answered the call to Episcopal priesthood being ordained in 1968. During this time he earned a B.A. and M.A. in Theology from Oxford and a B.D. and M.Div. from General Theological Seminary in New York. In 1976, Fr. Klores converted to Catholicism and was received into the Church. After trying a vocation with the Jesuits he accepted an invitation to join the Archdiocese of New Orleans. As a Catholic, Fr. Klores earned his S.T.L. and S.T.D. from the Pontifical Gregorian University in Rome. He was ordained in 1982 by Pope John Paul II. Returning to New Orleans in 1983, Fr. Klores has served as a spiritual director, taught at the seminary, worked as a parish priest, participated actively in the ecumenical movement, led many pilgrimages and directed many retreats.
