### Fr Tad Pacholczyk, Ph.D.

Fr. Tad is a priest of the diocese of Fall River, Massachusetts. As an undergraduate he earned degrees in philosophy, biochemistry, molecular cell biology, and chemistry. He earned a Ph.D. in neuroscience from Yale, where he focused on cloning genes for neurotransmitter transports expressed in the brain. He also worked as a molecular biologist at Massachusetts General Hospital. Fr. Tad studied for the priesthood and spent 5 years in Rome doing advanced work in dogmatic theology and in bioethics, examining the question of delayed ensoulment of the human embryo. Fr. Tad has testified on bioethics at state legislatures, and he has given presentations and participated in roundtables in the U.S., Canada, and Europe. Fr. Tad is currently Director of Education for the National Catholic Bioethics Center in Philadelphia.
